EMPEROR I® JAPANESE MAPLE

Acer palmatum 'Wolff'

00084

A graceful form with black-red bark veiled in dark red foliage that turns a brilliant scarlet in fall. Leaves bud out later in spring, better withstanding damage from late frosts than less cold hardy varieties. Displays most intense color in full sun exposure. Ideal as a colorful specimen in smaller landscapes. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 5 - 8

LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 15 ft. tall and wide.



VELVET VIKING™ JAPANESE MAPLE

Acer palmatum var. dissectum 'Monfrick' PP #31,864



Low, spreading branches on a beautifully mounded, weeping dwarf form. Rich, red, deeply dissected foliage holds its color throughout the growing season, developing more vibrant red tones in the fall. A lacy, delicate appearance yet exceptionally tough and cold tolerant. Thrives in full sun of cooler regions. An excellent container specimen. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Slow growing dwarf tree; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall, 6 to 8 ft. wide in 12 years.



CHOCOHOLIC SNAKEROOT

Actaea hybrid 'Chocoholic' PP #24,821

The burgundy-purple foliage of this large perennial makes a striking addition to a shady garden. Long, slender, pink, fragrant flower spikes tower above the foliage in the fall as the flowers fade to white. A standout in the shaded border, woodland, or cottage garden. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8

LIGHT: Full shade, Partial shade

AVERAGE SIZE: Foliage reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall and wide; flower spikes reach 4 to 5 ft. tall.



BLACK NEGLIGEE SNAKEROOT

Actaea simplex 'Black Negligee'

Deeply cut, serrated foliage emerges emerald green, then matures to a brilliant dark purple. Long, slender, pink-tinted, creamy white, fragrant flower spikes tower above the foliage in the fall. A standout in the shaded border, woodland or cottage garden. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 3 - 9

LIGHT: Full shade, Partial shade

AVERAGE SIZE: Foliage reaches 2 ft. tall and wide; flower spikes reach 5 to 6 ft. tall.



BRUNETTE SNAKEROOT

Actaea simplex 'Brunette'

47619

The purple-black foliage of this large perennial makes a striking addition to a shady garden. Long, slender, white, fragrant flower spikes tower above the foliage in late summer and fall. A standout in the shaded border, woodland, or cottage garden, attracting butterflies and hummingbirds. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

LIGHT: Filtered sun, Full shade, Partial shade, Partial sun **AVERAGE SIZE:** Reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide.



PINK SPIKE SNAKEROOT

Actaea simplex 'Pink Spike'

The chocolate-purple foliage of this large perennial makes a striking addition to a shady garden. Long, slender, light pink, fragrant flower spikes tower above the foliage in late summer and fall. A standout in the shaded border, woodland, or cottage garden, attracting butterflies and hummingbirds. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

LIGHT: Filtered sun, Full shade, Partial shade, Partial sun **AVERAGE SIZE:** Reaches 3 to 5 ft. tall, 1 to 2 ft. wide.



KIWI MAGIC® HARDY KIWI COMBINATION

Actinidia arguta (Male), Actinidia arguta 'Issai' (Female)

42411

A fruit-producing variety and a male pollinizer together in the same container, providing a higher yield of small, delicious smooth-skinned fruit. This vigorous vine offers glossy foliage and fragrant white blooms in early summer, making it a showy landscape specimen. Attractive on an arbor or trellis. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8

LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly climbs 20 to 25 ft. tall, spreading 12 to 20 ft., with support.



COBALT MILLENIUM ORNAMENTAL ONION


Allium x 'Cobalt Millenium' PPAF

47260

A unique sport of the popular Millenium ornamental onion, with its large rosy-pink blooms and a long flowering period, plus the added feature of blue-green foliage. Easy to care for and has excellent garden performance. Adored by bees. Perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 14 to 22 in. tall and wide.



BLACKHAWKS BIG BLUESTEM

Andropogon gerardii 'Blackhawks' PP #27,949

43977

A dramatic vertical accent that changes color throughout the growing season. Foliage emerges green, then develops red-bronze hues towards the tips in summer. The color continues to darken to deep purple until almost black in fall. Purple plumes appear in late summer.

USDA ZONES: 3 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 2 ft. wide, plumes 4 to 8 ft tall.



GOTEMBA GOLDEN JAPANESE SPIKENARD

Aralia cordata 'Gotemba'

05548

A sensational tall accent for a semi-shaded border or woodland garden. Each spring, brilliant yellow foliage emerges from a broad clump to create a grand, tree-like display. In late summer, sprays of white flowers climax in fireworks of shiny purplish black berries. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 10

LIGHT: Filtered sun, Partial shade, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Fast growing; reaches 5 to 8 ft. tall and wide annually.



BLOODSTONE THRIFT

Armeria maritima 'Bloodstone'

00304

A dependable plant for use in borders and along pathways. The dense, clump-forming, grassy-textured foliage forms neat green tufts topped by a profusion of bright, rosy red flower heads on stiff, upright stems. A wonderful rock garden accent or container plant. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 3 - 9

LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Foliage clumps reach 6 to 8 in. tall, 12 in. wide, with blooms 10 in. tall.



COTTON TAIL THRIFT

Armeria maritima 'Cotton Tail'

00269

This tidy, dense tuft of glossy green, grassy-textured foliage is an excellent choice for use in fronts of borders, edging pathways, and accenting rock gardens. Produces delightful, round, white blooms on stiff upright stems in spring, that will continue throughout summer if spent flowers are promptly removed. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 3 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Foliage reaches 4 to 6 in. tall and wide; blooms to 8 in. tall.



ROSE MILKWEED

Asclepias incarnata

42553

A must-have for sunny, wildlife-friendly gardens! Showy, rose-pink flowers are sweetly scented, clustered above tall stems with lush leaves, blooming throughout summer. Interesting seed-pods often persist into winter. This North American native tolerates swampy, boggy conditions, and may naturalize in wetland settings. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall, 1 to 3 ft. wide.



SHOWY MILKWEED

Asclepias speciosa

41563

This Western North American native lives up to its name with big orbs of star-shaped violet-pink flowers. An easy care plant that is tolerant of a variety of situations, from poor, dry soils to moist areas. A more manageable garden plant than common milkweed (Asclepias syriaca). An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 3 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 1 to 3 ft. tall, 1 to 2 ft. wide.



BUTTERFLY WEED

Asclepias tuberosa

This hardy, free-flowering, and well-behaved plant needs little attention. Adorns sunny gardens with clusters of attractive red buds that open to bright orange flowers throughout summer. Tolerant of lean, unimproved soils. Ideal for naturalized areas, meadows, and borders. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Fast growing, upright habit; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide.



GAY BUTTERFLIES MILKWEED

Asclepias tuberosa 'Gay Butterflies'

A brilliantly colored milkweed with fiery shades of red, orange, and yellow in summer. This easy-care, well-behaved plant needs little attention and provides wonderful color. Tolerant of lean, unimproved soils. Ideal for naturalized areas, meadows, and borders. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Fast growing, upright habit; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide.



GOLDEN ROCKET BARBERRY

Berberis thunbergii 'Golden Rocket' PP #18,626

06300

Expect dramatic color from spring to fall with this unique shrub with its narrow, upright habit and showy, bright yellow foliage that creates excellent color contrast in mixed borders. This variety produces few flowers and little to no viable seed, making it a great alternative over many other barberries. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Slowly reaches 3 to 5 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide.



GOLDEN RUBY® BARBERRY

Berberis thunbergii 'Goruzam' PP #16,203

03523

A handsome, compact shrub with colorful coral-orange foliage that lasts into autumn, then turns a brilliant mix of bright orange to brick red, accented with gold margins. Excellent as an accent, or plant in groupings in a low maintenance landscape. Rarely produces seedlings. Vigorous and hardy into USDA zone 3 with winter protection. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8

AVERAGE SIZE: Forms a dense, rounded shape, 2 ft. tall and wide.



GOLDEN NUGGET® DWARF JAPANESE BARBERRY

Berberis thunbergii 'Monlers'; CPBR #3489

01203

An exceptional golden barberry in an exciting dwarf form. Displays attractive, non-burning foliage with a golden orange cast most of the season. Excellent low-maintenance color for the landscape from spring to fall. Brightens beds and adds vibrant contrast to shrub borders. Heat and drought tolerant when established. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Slow growing; reaches only 12 in. tall, 18 in. wide.



ORANGE ROCKET BARBERRY

Berberis thunbergii 'Orange Rocket' PP #18,411

0629

Vibrant coral-orange new foliage ages to a medium green, then turns ruby red in autumn. This award-winning, compact shrub has a vigorous upright growth habit and improved resistance to rust. Use to brighten the landscape in mass plantings, as a specimen plant, or in a container. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 **LIGHT**: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 4 to 5 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide in 10 years.



LAVA NUGGET® MARTHA BARBERRY

Berberis thunbergii 'SMBTM' PP #30,594

40978

A compact, large-leaved barberry with bright orange-red new foliage that ages to a deep burgundy. Small yellow flowers appear in spring. The warm, rich color pairs beautifully with green or gold-leaved plants. Excellent for mass plantings, a low hedge or accent plant. Rust resistant and approved in states with rust restrictions. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 8 LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 3 ft. tall and wide.



BENGAL ORANGE BOUGAINVILLEA

Bougainvillea 'Bengal Orange'

03504

A very colorful and showy patio accent featuring bracts that resemble pinkish-orange flowers. A bright contrast set against the green and white variegated foliage. Offers a lush tropical effect and bright color over a long season. Evergreen in frost-free climates; provides superb warm season color in colder winter areas.

USDA ZONES: 10 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 6 to 8 ft. tall, 4 to 6 ft. wide, with support.



PURPLE QUEEN® BOUGAINVILLEA

Bougainvillea 'Moneth'

01305

Rich, deep purple, petal-like bracts are displayed against handsome, deep green foliage. A wonderful compact, upright and spreading form that works well in planter boxes, and on fences and arbors. Evergreen in frost-free areas; use as a colorful annual in cooler northern zones.

USDA ZONES: 10 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Climbs 15 ft. tall with support; 1 to 2 ft. tall, 8 ft. wide as groundcover.



OO-LA-LA® BOUGAINVILLEA

Bougainvillea 'Monka'

01326

Vibrant, magenta-red flowers that bloom longer than most bougainvilleas. The compact, dwarf form is wonderful for cascading over hanging baskets, or as a spreading groundcover. Exquisite patio tree form creates a stunning accent to landscapes and container gardens. Evergreen in frost-free areas; use as a colorful annual in cooler northern zones.

USDA ZONES: 10 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 1 to 2 ft. tall, 6 to 8 ft. wide.



RASPBERRY ICE BOUGAINVILLEA

Bougainvillea 'Raspberry Ice'

01321

A beautiful, low, mounded, spreading form with a profusion of raspberry-pink blossom-like bracts and contrasting variegated foliage. Perfect for hanging baskets, or as a colorful shrub or groundcover in small sunny spaces. One of the hardiest varieties! Evergreen in frost-free climates; provides superb warm season color in colder winter areas.

USDA ZONES: 10 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall, 5 to 6 ft. wide.



CHICAGOLAND GREEN® BOXWOOD

Buxus x 'Glencoe'

Chosen by the Chicago Botanic Garden for outstanding cold hardiness, this resilient boxwood holds its glossy green foliage well in winter. Resembling an English boxwood in appearance, it has a uniform oval habit making it a fantastic low hedge, either sculpted or informal. An excellent foundation plant or background for perennials. Evergreen.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Grows 2 to 3 in. per year, slowly reaching 3 to 4 ft. tall and wide.



CLEOPATRA CANNA

Canna 'Cleopatra'

44767

This colorful perennial is sure to be enjoyed by the adventurous gardener! You can't predict what you will get with this unstable variety. Flowers may be yellow with red spots, pure red, or a combination of the two, while the leaves vary from green to chocolate brown. The large flowers are dazzling no matter what colors appear. A perfect plant for collectors or casual gardeners alike.

USDA ZONES: 8 - 11 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 3 to 4 ft. tall, 2 to 3 ft. wide.



GOLDEN CHARM THREAD-BRANCH CYPRESS

Chamaecyparis pisifera filifera 'Golden Charm'

02403

A compact conifer with interesting, thread-like needles that weep and drape over the entire shrub. Bright, golden yellow new foliage, even in full sun. An excellent semi-erect, mop-headed landscape specimen or accent plant that makes a nice background border or small hedge. Slow growing; size can be maintained with minimal pruning. Evergreen.

GOLDEN SPIRIT SMOKE TREE


Cotinus coggygria 'Ancot'

Spectacular foliage emerges lime green, matures to brilliant gold in summer, then turns coral, orange and red in fall. Showy smoke-like plumes of airy, pale pink flowers provide stunning summer interest. Foliage is sun tolerant and scorch-resistant unless conditions are extremely dry. Wonderful for use as a small specimen tree. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 10 LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 8 ft. tall, 6 ft. wide.



LILLA SMOKE BUSH

Cotinus coggygria 'Lilla'

41598

A dwarf form of the beloved "Royal Purple' cultivar, perfectly proportioned for smaller gardens. Forms a small, rounded, deciduous shrub with all of the color and interest of its larger cousin. Frothy plumes of pink flowers rise above the wine red foliage in the summer. Oval leaves turn shades of bright orange, coral, and red in the fall. A big impact in sunny borders with very low maintenance.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 10 LIGHT: Full sun, Partial sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 4 ft. tall and wide.



ROYAL PURPLE SMOKE TREE

Cotinus coggygria 'Royal Purple'

02814

Dramatic, long-lasting, pinkish purple, smoke-like airy seed clusters backed by reddish purple foliage create a prized small tree or large accent shrub. Foliage holds its color all summer, then turns scarlet red in autumn. Deciduous.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 10 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 15 ft. tall, 10 to 12 ft. wide.



SUNSEEKERS™ GOLDEN SUN CONEFLOWER

Echinacea 'Golden Sun'

47170

An abundance of beautiful semi-double flowers bloom throughout summer. Layers of golden-yellow petals with a slight fringe at the tips encircle nectar-rich orange cones. Attracts pollinators to sunny perennial beds and makes an excellent cut flower. Perennial.

SUNMAGIC PETITE BURGUNDY CONEFLOWER


Echinacea 'Petite Burgundy'

47227

A miniature coneflower of exceptionally small stature. The smaller blooms are packed so tightly and in such abundance that they look like a bouquet! Magenta-red petals surround a burgundy center. Excellent on its own in a small container on a tabletop, in larger mixed containers, or at the very front of a perennial bed. Herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches just 10 in. tall and wide.



SUNSEEKERS™ PUMPKIN PIE CONEFLOWER

Echinacea 'Pumpkin Pie'

47172

An abundance of beautiful semi-double flowers bloom throughout summer. Layers of orange petals encircle nectar-rich green cones. The orange tone starts with more yellow and ages to peachy hues. Attracts pollinators to sunny perennial beds and makes an excellent cut flower. Perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 18 to 24 in. tall, 16 in wide.



SUNSEEKERS™ SWEET FUCHSIA CONEFLOWER

Echinacea 'Sweet Fuchsia'

47173

An abundance of beautiful semi-double flowers bloom throughout summer. Layers of fuchsia-red pointed petals encircle nectar-rich bright green cones that darken as the blooms age. Attracts pollinators to sunny perennial beds and makes an excellent cut flower. Perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 18 to 24 in. tall, 16 in wide.



SWEET SANDIA CONEFLOWER

Echinacea 'Sweet Sandia'

44827

A sweet celebration of summer. The petals look like slices of watermelon, with deep pink centers and light green edges. Flowers prolifically on a compact habit. An eye-catching addition to sunny summer borders. Herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly Reaches 19 to 24 in. tall, 16 in. wide.



SUNSEEKERS™ WHITE PERFECTION CONEFLOWER

Echinacea 'White Perfection'

47175

An abundance of beautiful semi-double flowers bloom throughout summer. Layers of white petals encircle nectar-rich dark green cones that change to vivid lemon yellow as the blooms age. Attracts pollinators to sunny perennial beds and makes an excellent cut flower. Perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 18 to 24 in. tall, 16 in. wide.



EVOLUTION™ COLORIFIC™ CONEFLOWER

Echinacea hybrid 'Balevoeen' PP #30,998

An enchanting green cone - as green as the leaves - at the center of every bloom, framed by dense petals in a lovely palette of pink hues. Lush foliage and sturdy, upright stems create a beautiful backdrop for the continuous profusion of blooms from late spring through fall. Stunning in beds, borders and containers. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 18 to 20 in. tall, 18 in. wide.



EVOLUTION™ FIESTA CONEFLOWER

Echinacea hybrid 'Balevoesta' PP #31,029

Fiesta provides a riot of color with spicy coral-pink flowers that age to softer shades. New flowers emerge throughout summer, providing a lively display. A cutting garden essential, and perfect for containers or borders. Leave dried flower heads on the plants in the fall for an added architectural element in the landscape. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 18 to 20 in. tall, 18 in. wide.



MOAB SUNSET CONEFLOWER

Echinacea hybrid 'Moab Sunset' PPAF

Exceptional, intense red-orange double blooms blanket this perennial with long-lasting color summer through fall. The compact, upright habit and short stature is perfect in garden beds or containers. A stunning addition to sunny summer bouquets.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

AVERAGE SIZE: Foliage reaches 12 in. tall, 14 in. wide. Flowers to 20 in. tall.



EVOLUTION™ EMBERS™ FEVER CONEFLOWER

Echinacea hybrid 'TNECHEF' PP #31,466

No summer perennial garden should be without coneflowers, which sail through heat and some drought with ease, typically blooming into fall. This one sports large red blooms on a tidy, well-branching plant that makes it ideal for adding bold color to mixed borders, containers, and cutting gardens. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 18 to 20 in. tall, 18 in. wide.



RUBY STAR CONEFLOWER

Echinacea purpurea 'Ruby Star'

Flower petals are first held horizontally, then relax as the flowers age and the cone-like centers become more pronounced. The bright purple-pink, daisy-like flowers on sturdy stems make great cut flowers. An ideal choice for adding color to sunny, waterwise borders and mixed containers. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 2 to 3 ft. tall, 2 ft. wide.



SOMBRERO® SANGRITA CONEFLOWER

Echinacea x 'Balsomanita' PP #30,138

Vibrant scarlet-red blooms on upright burgundy-red stems top this sturdy, compact plant. A fuss-free, cheerful choice for a sunny, easy-care low summer border. Drought tolerant and hardy, with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Quickly reaches 18 to 20 in. tall, 22 to 24 in. wide.



SOMBRERO® SALSA RED CONEFLOWER

Echinacea \times 'Balsomsed' PP #23,105

08684

Big, bright red blooms for an easy, colorful summer border. A must-have for sunny gardens, this drought tolerant perennial was bred for cold hardiness and compact form with prolific flowering over an exceptionally long season. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9

AVERAGE SIZE: Moderate growing; reaches 24 to 26 in. tall, 16 to 22 in. wide.



PRIMA™ RUBY CONEFLOWER

Echinacea x 'TNECHPR' PP #30,204

A blooming powerhouse, this summer perennial favorite is packed with bold red flowers with dark eyes. Blooms continue from early summer to first frost. This short, compact variety is perfect for the front of perennial beds. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 15 in. tall and wide.



PRIMA™ SAFFRON CONEFLOWER

Echinacea x 'TNECHPS'

A blooming powerhouse, this summer perennial favorite is packed with vibrant yellow and orange flowers. Blooms continue from early summer to first frost. This short, compact variety is perfect for the front of perennial beds. An herbaceous perennial.

USDA ZONES: 4 - 9 LIGHT: Full sun

AVERAGE SIZE: Reaches 18 in. tall, 20 in. wide.



HARDY PAMPAS GRASS
